

## Report of Junior Department for 2021 - 2022 Judi White, Director

Worthy State Master, Officers and Members of the RI State Grange,

I'm honored to be submitting my tenth report as Junior Director. It was great to resume some of our normal events that have been interrupted over the last two years. Right after State Session in October the committee began planning the Junior Program for 2022, we did decide that the contests and activity day would be held at a meeting of each Junior Grange separately instead of having statewide events to keep the size of the group at lower numbers due to Covid-19 still being prevalent.

The month of November brings the cold air and the arduous task of producing the Junior Department books which requires me to acquire the pages from the other Department Heads, which continues to be a struggle. This year I decided to rely further on the department website to lessen the number of pages in the book, which reduces printing costs. However, not as many people are using the website as I hoped, and I received several comments that information was not included in the books. The books were distributed to Junior, Subordinate and Pomona Granges at the end of November. National Grange Convention was held in Wichita, Kansas. Annette Hartley received Best of Show for her Creative Writing Entry titled "What I Would Do If I Were National Master for a Day"; she also received the Cape of Honor - Gold Tier Award for over 500 hours of community service. Annette was also awarded National Junior Granger of the Year. Every year there is a meeting hosted by the National Junior Director, for all Junior Directors, to go over the National Grange Junior Programs for the upcoming year. I was able to attend this meeting virtually and gain a lot of information regarding the various programs offered for the Juniors.

In December, we received word that Maine had cancelled the Northeast Leaders Conference that was scheduled for March; this meant that the Junior Directors would not have an opportunity to get together to choose a craft for the Big E. The Massachusetts Junior Director reached out via email in March and a Big E Craft was chosen, as soon as I received the information, I forwarded it on to the Junior Leaders.

Unfortunately, due to scheduling issues Newport County Junior Grange #41 opted to not host the State Contests and Activity Day this year.
